## Important News - Criminal Records checks - 'Disclosure'

In the November *Newsletter*, we reported that our National Executive Committee was pursuing two alternative options, with the RLSS - the Royal Life Saving Society and the STA - Swimming Teachers Association, due to the problem created by NASCH who had <u>de-registered</u> and would no longer be acting as the Registered Umbrella Body with the Criminal Records Bureau.

When this first happened back in May 2006, <u>Jim O'Neil</u> husband of Carol O'Neill (who had been the contact for CRB checks with NASCH) wrote to us to say that he himself was applying to the CRB to become independently registered to carry out CRB checks. As many of you already know, Jim O'Neil has written to say that he is now registered and is able to offer the same service as that previously available through NASCH.

Thus, at the meeting of our National Executive on Sunday, 5th November, they agreed that Halliwick AST would advise any of our affiliated clubs to use his services. His company is 'Ceejay Services', 29 Shaw St, Hoylake, Wirral, Merseyside CH47 2BW Tel No: 0151-632 2047 E-mail: <a href="mailto:jimoneil@btinternet.com">jimoneil@btinternet.com</a>; the cost being £5 per CRB check. Clubs should make contact direct with Jim O'Neil for the appropriate forms. For those clubs who have previously used NASCH, you will need to re-register details of your CPO (Child Protection Officer) with him, at no charge, otherwise there will be a £20, one-off, registration fee. He is also able to process CRB checks for individual Halliwick affiliates at a fee.

As an alternative, you may wish to contact the RLSS - the Royal Life Saving Society, where to partake in their scheme <u>each individual club</u> would first have to affiliate, at an annual cost of £39, but then <u>each CRB check is FREE</u>. ## HALLIWICK STUDY DAY


