Transit Seats

Before the installation of Hoists, this was essential piece equipment. Recently we have been asked by another club, from where they can be purchased, because their pool hoist was temporarily out of use.

For those who are not familiar with this item, it is 'a simple hardwearing polyester seat with 4 corner handles designed to help two people to transfer another to and from a wheelchair, toilet, shower, swimming pool etc..'

This item, which is a special manufacture, can be obtained from **Tyco Healthcare** who can be contacted by phone on **0800 - 581 596** for more details.

The price excluding VAT is approx £104.

We would point out that we do not necessarily endorse this product and it is advisable to carry out a 'risk assessment' before using.

Remember, one of the advantages of being an Affiliated club is that you can apply to the 'Keyhaven Fund' for help in purchasing this type of item.
