Important News - Criminal Records checks - 'Disclosure'

People will, by now, be familiar with 'Disclosure'. This is the process whereby Criminal Records checks are undertaken for clubs/members of our Association by **NASCH** as the Registered body. At the end of April we received some disturbing news from NASCH, in that they had de-registered and had communicated direct with our clubs concerned, who were affected by this discussion!

You will remember that we produced and distributed to all affiliated clubs at the end of Nov 2003 our publication 'Safe to Swim' - in 3 parts - which was our definitive guide. At the time, rather than registering ourselves as an umbrella body, which was rather costly, we came to an arrangement with NASCH that they would act as the Registered Umbrella Body with the Criminal Records Bureau. Clubs are therefore at this time unable to use NASCH.

Your National Executive Committee discussed this problem at their last meeting on June 11th and are at present exploring the alternatives and will keep you informed. *In the meantime you may consider approaching your local Council for Voluntary Service (CVS) to see if they can help.*

This is the first such Study Day to be held in London, and, if this is as popular as we anticipate, we plan to hold more in different parts of the country. These Study Days are intended for anyone who has done a Halliwick Foundation Course and is using Halliwick in the course of their work, either therapeutically or for swimming teaching. There will be an opportunity to put questions to our Halliwick experts as well as learn more about putting Halliwick into practice, and it will also be a chance to meet others who are using Halliwick, to exchange ideas & experiences. Apart from further Study Days, our plans at present include a Halliwick Paediatric Therapy Course next summer and a Halliwick Adult Therapy Course at sometime in the future.

Attendance at all these and any other events will be open to anyone who has done a basic Halliwick training, but there will be considerable discounts for <u>Affiliated</u> Members of Halliwick AST.
