### Important News - Criminal Records checks - 'Disclosure'

In the July *Newsletter*, we reported that our National Executive Committee would be discussing the problem created by NASCH who had <u>de-registered</u> and would no longer be acting as the Registered Umbrella Body with the Criminal Records Bureau.

We are now pursuing two options. <u>Firstly</u>, through the **RLSS** - the Royal Life Saving Society, following information received from one of our affiliated clubs, namely Hull Optimists SC, who are now using the RLSS for this purpose. To partake in this scheme each individual club would first have to affiliate to the RLSS at an annual cost of £39, but then <u>each CRB check is FREE!</u> <u>Secondly</u>, through the STA - Swimming Teachers Association, where there is <u>no requirement</u> to affiliate, but <u>each CRB check costs £8</u>.

We have now received information from both the RLSS and STA about their schemes, which the National Executive Committee will be discussing at their meeting on 5th Nov. Depending on the outcome of their discussions, they may well be recommending one or either, or both of these schemes to our affiliated clubs. If a club does more than Five CRB checks in a year, then the RLSS scheme is the most cost effective.

As soon as a decision has been made, we will let you know and forward copies of the necessary forms that you will need in order to take part in either CRB scheme.

Unfortunately, the **Halliwick Study Day** that had been arranged for Oct 7<sup>th</sup> at Linden Lodge, Wimbledon Park, London SW19, had to be postponed because the pool was out of action.

We will let you know the re-arranged date in due course.
