
News from Conquest SC who swim at the Beckenham Spa, Kent

We did not have to queue and I was helped up and down stairs and when available taken up and down in lifts. I was taken by a friend to *Buckingham Palace* who had made previous arrangements.

With my Disabled parking tickets we drove in through the front gates and were shown where to park. From there, the 3 of us were taken in a buggy in through the inner door, where a wheel chair was waiting for me. This meant that I was pushed by friends along the corridors and up and down in lifts to the State Apartments. We were lucky enough to see the Treasurers of the Faberge collection and the Royal Wedding cake.

The entrance fee is not cheap, but the contents of the State rooms and the amazing collection of paintings made it worth while. Buckingham Palace is now closed until Spring 2012. Windsor Castle and St George's Castle are open all the year round. For more details contact:
