A message from the Chair

On Sunday 29th April we held our 2012 Annual General Meeting in Oxford at the Barton Leisure Centre, Waynflete Road, Headington, Oxford OX3 8GA, followed by the first meeting of the newly elected National Executive Committee.

At the AGM it was agreed that we will not increase <u>Insurance Fees for 2013 - 2014</u>, as we are only too aware of the financial problems that many clubs are experiencing in the present climate. The dates of the 2012 - 2013 National meetings were agreed upon & appear under <u>'Dates for your Diary'</u> on <u>page 2</u>. **Keith Beer,** Chair ASTRA 15, stood down as Vice President and his valuable contribution over many years was acknowledged. **William Wyatt**, Chair of Halliwick Penguins SC was appointed.

For many years, one of the benefits that clubs get from affiliating to Halliwick AST is that they are exempt from having to pay a licence fee to PPL (use of music) when playing original music. (Tapes, CDs etc) on the bathside etc at their swim sessions. We have recently found that the law was amended in January 2010 so that Charities no longer exempt. If any club does do this, they must first check with their pool management that they are covered by the Pools own licence with PPL. If not, they will be In breach of the regulations, unless they purchase such a licence, which may cost as much as £106!!

Halliwick Study Day – Saturday April 28th - Claremont School, Bristol

On Saturday April 28th, 17 people attended a Halliwick Study Day in Bristol which included a varied programme of talks and pool sessions.

Pamela Galloway shared her experience of setting up a number of Halliwick groups in the Bath area including the involvement of parents and her success in obtaining funding. In a pool demonstration with some of the children, she showed how she applies Halliwick with individual children and with a mixed ability group.

Ann Thomson gave a presentation about Outcomes with particular reference to SWIM, Swim with Independent Measurement, the system based on the Ten Point Programme. It provides a very easy but graphic way of measuring & recording swimmers progress and has recently been validated by Katya Srsen, a research doctor and Halliwick lecturer in Slovenia for reliability including inter-rater reliability

Following a presentation about the new National Open College Network (OCN) accreditation for Halliwick courses and the requirements for the Halliwick Instructors Competency Certificate, participants were able to try out some of the sections of the SWIM assessment in the pool. This was also an opportunity to practice both their pool skills for their HIC and many found this very valuable.

Everyone who attended was very enthusiastic and, as much as the talks and pool sessions, they found the chance to meet other people using Halliwick and share experiences, was a valuable part of the day. It is planned to hold more Study Days in the future so keep your eyes open here and on the website for the next one.
