

Proposal for purchasing Regional Gala medals - 2014

For many years Regional gala medals have been purchased centrally but this arrangement has resulted in problems. Also increased cost of postage has outweighed the advantage of bulk buying. The Executive committee has agreed that each region is to purchase its own medals and ribbons. If this causes financial hardship, the region can apply for a grant in the usual way. Halliwick AST will continue to provide medal centres. To save postage, the centres can be collected at the AGM or the previous National gala. An important note on PPL - Music licensing for recorded music played in public.

Club Leads, Chairs, Chief Instructors please note that it is your responsibility as a Club officer to ensure that you comply with the law relating to the playing of recorded music in public. If your Club uses recorded music for swimming sessions then you will almost certainly have to get a PPL separate from the centre or school in which you conduct your swimming sessions. Product Information Sheet: Transfer Aids by Jane Stewart-Parry

<u>Transit Seat:</u> For many years Halliwick AST advocated the use of the transit seat to transfer wheelchair users between different surfaces. It had the advantage of being highly flexible and allowed the weight to be spread between up to 4 helpers. If you are still using one in your club make sure it is a good state of repair with no frayed edges, loose stitching, discolouration of the material or other indication of wear and tear. The Transit Seat is no longer produced and if members decide to undertake repairs to an existing product they could be liable if there was an injury.



The Ann-Yang Pool Evacuation Sling: This is designed to remove swimmers from the water in an emergency for example following an epileptic seizure. It is not advocated as part of a normal operating procedure. The standard method requires the use of an additional glide sheet and Airex mat to protect the user as they are placed on poolside. Care must be taken when using the glide sheet to make sure it is well clear of user's feet.

The advantages of this product are that it wraps around the user and protects their head and limbs from injury. For some swimmers this has a calming effect when leaving the pool.



NB DO NOT STAND ON GLIDE SHEET

There are substantial disadvantages from using a glide sheet near the feet of the poolside helpers and a detailed risk assessment would be required to ensure safe practice for all those involved.



<u>Promove Sling:</u> The Promove sling is promoted as both an emergency evacuation sling and a transfer aid. It also comes with extension straps to allow carers of different heights or for a range of levels to assist with transfers. It is much easier to fit under the user due to its clever wrap around design. It comes in three sizes: under 8, under 12 and 12 to adult with or without a head support. The basic sling allows up to 4 users to share the load & up to 8 with the extension straps. Cost (January 2014) £250.80 plus cost of bag and additional
