What a fun afternoon we had at this year's national championships, hosted by Halliwick ASTRA 1 in Southgate, North London on 14th October 2017!

We were delighted to welcome the Deputy Mayor of Enfield, Cllr. Doris Jiagge, to the event to present trophies and medals.

4 Halliwick ASTRAs (regions) took part: Halliwick ASTRA 1 (Greater London—North of the River Thames); Halliwick ASTRA 2 (Greater London—South of the River Thames, Kent Surrey and Sussex); Halliwick ASTRA 5 (Yorkshire); and Halliwick ASTRA 8 (Cheshire, Staffordshire and Shropshire).

It was great to see so many take part and swim so well.

Final placing was as follows: Halliwick ASTRA 5 (45 points); Halliwick ASTRA 1 (44 points); Halliwick ASTRA 2 (40 points); Halliwick ASTRA 8 (30 points).

That means that this year's national champions are **Halliwick ASTRA 5** and their team received the **Barnardo Trophy**.

Congratulations to Halliwick ASTRA 5 in what was an exciting afternoon of swimming!


